CHECKLIST

Use of Monoclonal Antibody (Casirivimab + Imdevimab) for Post-exposure Prophylaxis for COVID-19 in High-Risk Individuals

INCLUSION CRITERIA

Asymptomatic
Known exposure to COVID-19 positive Patient (for at least 15 minutes in a 24-hour period)
COVID-19 negative (by PCR or Ag Test)
Not fully Vaccinated
High Risk is defined as subjects who meet ONE of the following criteria:
 ≥ 65 years of age
 Obesity (BMI >25 kg/m²; if age 12-17 years, BMI > 85th percentile for age and gender as per CDC growth charts (<u>https://www.cdc.gov/growthcharts/clinical_charts.htm</u>)
Chronic kidney disease
Pregnancy
Diabetes
Immunosuppressive disease or currently receiving immunosuppressive treatment
Cardiovascular diseases (including congenital heart disease) or hypertension
Chronic lung diseases (e.g., COPD; Asthma [moderate-severe]; CF; interstitial lung disease; pulmonary HTN)
Sickle cell disease
Neurodevelopmental disorder (e.g., cerebral palsy)
Tracheostomy, Gastrostomy or positive pressure ventilation (unrelated to COVID-19)
Genetic or metabolic syndromes and severe congenital abnormalities
Racial & ethnic minorities (e.g., Hispanics-Latinos, African Americans)

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

COVID-19 positive
Symptomatic
