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Q&A: FOURTH DOSE OF PFIZER COVID-19 mRNA VACCINE

- Q: Why get the fourth dose of Pfizer COVID-19 mRNA vaccine?
- A: Recent evidence from clinical studies have shown that the best protection against the current pandemic due to Omicron variant is afforded by getting a fourth dose of Pfizer COVID-19 mRNA vaccine 90 days after the third dose of the vaccine
- Q: Is this treatment approved by the FDA?
- A: Yes, FDA has reviewed the protocol and after much deliberations extended an Expanded Access Authorization. DHR Health Institute for Research & Development is the first and only entity in the US which has received formal approval from the FDA to administer the fourth dose.
- Q: Which vaccine will be used for this protocol:
- A: Pfizer (Comirnaty; Pfizer/BioNTech) COVID-19 mRNA vaccine will be used for the fourth dose
- Q: Who would qualify for fourth dose of the Pfizer COVID-19 mRNA vaccine?
- A: The following individuals would qualify for the fourth dose:
 - >18 years of age
 - Healthcare worker, and/or
 - ≥65 years of age, and/or
 - Immunocompromised
 - ≥90 days after the third dose of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine
- Q: Where will the treatment be administered?
- A: Under controlled condition, the fourth dose will be administered in a "safe" zone in the DHR Health Institute for Research & Development
- Q: Is there any cost to the subjects?
- A: COVID-19 vaccine is available free-of-cost. However, there is standard cost for administering the vaccine and post-vaccine monitoring. This is billed to insurance or third party and/or to the patient
